1. What kinds of activities and topics do you typically prepare for your presentation?

We offer presentations on the benefits of volunteering. The presentation will cover the following topics but can be tailored to suit the needs of the class or group.

- How volunteerism can help develop job skills or serve as a stage to learn transferable skills for future employability.
- Benefits to the community.
- Information on scholarships and bursaries for students.
- Information on accessing High School credit through volunteering.

2. How long is the presentation?

It usually takes between 20-45 minutes and a 15-minute Q & A session (if class is interactive).
