- Ensuring strong fiduciary oversight and financial management
- Approving and monitoring Volunteer Manitoba's programs and services
- Enhancing Volunteer Manitoba's public image

We are currently recruiting new members for our Board of Directors that possess the following attributes:

- Experience as a Board Director in a governance role
- Experience in marketing, public relations, philanthropy or legal expertise
- Willingness and availability to participate in sub-committees

As part of our mission to promote and recognize volunteerism across all of Manitoba, through connecting all Manitobans in volunteerism, we strongly encourage applications from individuals who:

- Self-identify as Indigenous, or have experience working with Indigenous communities or organizations; or
- Self-identify as belonging to communities which have been historically disadvantaged and marginalized in Manitoba.

Preference will also be given to candidates who have experience working with community based non-profit organizations.

Successful individuals would be required to:

- Prepare for and participate in monthly Board meetings. Average monthly time commitment between 2 – 6 hours (varies). Meetings are typically held in the evening and are done virtually.
- Participate in the development of a strategic plan to help guide future decisions
- Abide by the by-laws, code of conduct and other policies that apply to the Board
- Help establish, review, and monitor operational policies
- Listen to others' views, advocate their own, identify common interests and alternatives, and be open to compromise
- Have a commitment to the mission of the organization
